OYC Guest Chalets

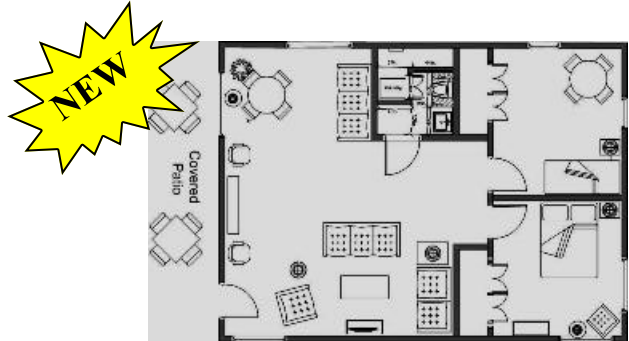
Following the purchase of the additional acreage beyond OYC, we continue to look for ways to improve the services we can offer to visitor's in our area.

Engineers and excavators have been working diligently to finalize the plans for the new OYC entrance off Bagnell Dam Blvd. When the new entrance is complete, it will allow for the expansion of Guest Chalets on the property. Currently, construction is taking place on the first Chalet, *The Dock House* and should be available for occupancy by Spring 2011.

The Dock House is located on Dock W and will be available for nightly or extended use by members and guests. It features a gathering area with an electric fireplace, 2 bedrooms and 1 bathroom. *The Dock House* can sleep up to 6 guests. Boat slips are also available during your stay.

What's Happening around OYC

At the end of December, OYC purchased and installed 12 new dock de-icers. With the extreme cold weather here, these de-icers will aide in the protection of our docks as well as members' boats.

New Fuel Dock – Upgrades to the fuel dock will be enjoyed by everyone. Additional slips have been added as well as an extension to the lay-along which will allow us to better serve our customers. New padding and ropes will increase the protection of your boat. Extra dock space was created as a courtesy deck and features tables and chairs, so you can enjoy a cold beverage and a light breeze while refueling your boat.

Installation of brand new fuel pumps will increase the dispensing capacity by 50%, which allows for faster fuel and diesel service. The pumps are electronic for improved accuracy.

For the OYC Service Dept., we have added a 2011 GMC Heavy-Duty truck for haul-outs and over-the-road hauling. This addition will allow our Service Dept. to better serve our customers.

By Spring, safety ladders will be located on each dock. These ladders will provide an easy exit from the water in case of accidental entry.

As a courtesy, we have purchased large protective bumpers which are available to our members. They can be installed at the entrance to any slip in order to protect against strong winds, large wakes or any obstacle that might interfere with a safe docking experience. The Catalina 355 is new to the fleet of Catalina Yachts on display at OYC. Currently we carry the 8ft. Sabot, 12.5 Expo, 16.5 day sailor and 309 cruiser. The 355 is has just been recognized by *Cruising World Magazine* as the Domestic Boat of the Year and Best Midsize for 2011.



Catalina boasts the 355 as versatile, fast, comfortable, spacious and safe. Presenting a new hull design with a long waterline, moderate beam and freeboard, and a handsome low-profile cabin structure.

Long, inboard Genoa tracks accommodate headsails from a powerful 155% Genoa to a storm jib, allowing a balanced sail plan for all wind conditions.

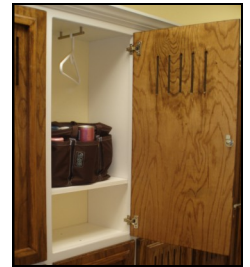
Additional features are a forward berth with innerspring mattress, a dedicated filter locker, large cockpit locker with gull wing hatch and available quad-leaf folding table.

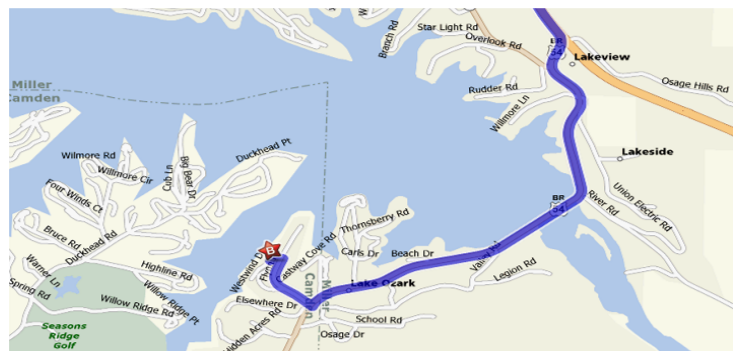

Directions to OYC

The OYC is located on beautiful Lake of the Ozarks, a comfortable 2 hours by car from St. Louis

Coming southwest on Highway 54 from Jefferson City, exit at Bagnell Dam and proceed on **Business 54** one mile across the dam to Flynn Road.

Turn right onto Flynn Road (at the roadside clock). Go 0.2 miles, then turn left onto Westwind Drive. After 0.1 mile you will arrive at the Ozark Yacht Club.
