## Fiberglass, Gel Coat & Paint

In October, Ozark Yacht Club completed an extensive training program on fiberglass repair and gel coat application. The course was conducted by American Boat Restoration's very own David Weakley, nationally known as the premier instructor for fiberglass repair, color restoration and gel coat structural repairs. You may have read some articles by Weakley. His pen name is "Mr. Gel". His instructions truly matched his reputation.

Brett Davis, James Dale, Dominic Alberti and Tim Shields attended the class which included hands-on instruction

of color restoration, grinding gel coat and fiberglass damage to prepare for repair, mixing and applying fiber fillers, sanding and prepping gel coat, shooting gel coat, finish sanding, compounding and buffing. Also included was instruction on the proper way to repair blisters, holes, air voids, stress cracks, fractures and common dock rash.

The program was unmatched in the Lake area. In order to further build on these unique skills, we are installing a temperature controlled dust-free paint booth and high-performance scaffolding to accommodate boats up to 50ft.

Having beautifully performed several restorations since the course, Brett Davis will be the lead technician on fiberglass and paint jobs to assure top quality results on cosmetic and structural repairs.

**OYC Expansion Update**

We continue to look into the future with great optimism: the massive rock excavation phase of our 15-acre expansion project has been completed, awaiting only landscaping, seeding and paving of *OYC Parkway* next spring.

*Golden Pond* is now full and prepared to host some wild-life.

*Rialto Bridge* (yes, there is one in Venice too, but it isn't made for golf carts!!) will open to recreational traffic by Christmas.



Our plan for *Princess Beach* has been approved by Ameren; we plan to take advantage of the seasonal low water levels to remove debris, grade a gentle slope and place sand along the shoreline.

*Pine House* has been remodeled on the outside and indoor renovations will be completed over the winter months.

*Cedar House* has just come off the drawing table; construction will begin soon, weather permitting, for completion early summer 2012.

Both houses will be available for short or extended stays.

And FERC has finally approved the addition of two docks in the cove south of Dock W. Together, these docks will add about 25 covered and open slips to our capacity, further increasing the OYC's economies of scale, an important factor to delivering outstanding value to our customers.

We are currently working on designs to fit these docks nicely into the landscape while offering the signature OYC amenities such as patios, golf cart access and convenient parking.

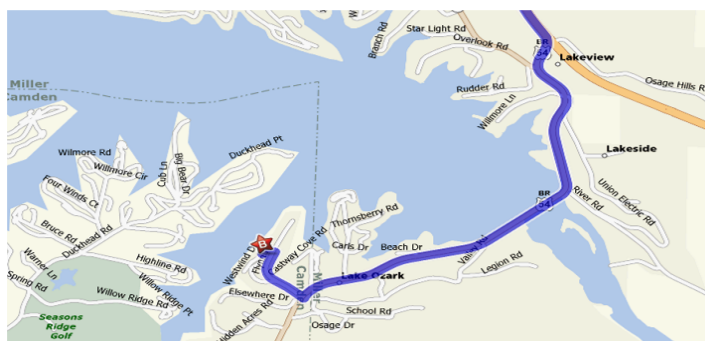

## Directions to OYC

The OYC is located on beautiful Lake of the Ozarks, a comfortable 2 hours by car from St. Louis.

Coming southwest on Hwy 54 from Jefferson City, exit at Bagnell Dam and proceed on **Business 54** one mile across the dam to Flynn Road. Turn right onto Flynn Road (at the roadside clock). Go 0.2 miles, then turn left onto Westwind Drive. After 0.1 mile you will arrive at the Ozark Yacht Club.

By water, go to the 1-mile marker, turn south into Jennings Branch Cove to OYC. Use courtesy slips on the fuel dock.
